



PREMIER'S AWARDS FOR INDIGENOUS YOUTH EXCELLENCE IN SPORT

About the Awards

The Premier's Awards for Indigenous Youth Excellence in Sport recognize athletes who have achieved excellence in performance sport and are regarded for their leadership qualities both on and off the field of play. Nominations will be accepted for youth athletes 24 years of age or younger (born in 1999 or later) who are competing in performance sport. A maximum of 36 Regional Awards will be given out, with up to six awards within each of I·SPARC's regions: Northeast, Northwest, Interior, Fraser, Vancouver Coastal, and Vancouver Island. Recipients will be selected and honoured at virtual regional ceremonies held late 2023.

Athletes selected for the Regional Awards will automatically serve as nominees for the Provincial Awards. A total of 10 Provincial Awards will be given out. Provincial recipients will receive an invitation in the spring of 2024 to attend a virtual Provincial Awards ceremony, their profile will go on display at the BC Sports Hall of Fame, and they will receive a cash bursary.

Nomination & Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the awards, an athlete must meet the following criteria:

- Has been a permanent resident of BC for the last 12 months
- Is of Indigenous ancestry (First Nations, Métis, and/or Inuit)
- Is 24 years of age or younger (born in 1999 or later)
- Is actively participating in a recognized provincial sport and/or regional/traditional sport and shows evidence of high athletic ability and performance results
- Is enrolled in school, actively pursuing or planning to pursue a post-secondary education
- Past Regional recipients remain eligible until they are 25 years of age
- Past Provincial recipients are <u>not eligible</u> to receive the award in subsequent years

Selection Criteria

Regional Selection Committees will assess nominees using the following five criteria:

Sport Achievements — Pursuing and achieving sport performances leading towards podium placements at regional, provincial, national, and international competitions

Leadership Qualities — Demonstrating the qualities of leadership, coachability, strong work ethic, and the characteristics of fair play both on and off the field of play

Education — Demonstrating a commitment to academic studies and continued education

Cultural Awareness — Demonstrating pride in their Indigenous ancestry and being actively

Future Goals — Demonstrating how their experience in sport is shaping their future

Only those competitive results and accomplishments achieved between **September 25**, **2022** and **September 25**, **2023** will be assessed. Nomination forms must be completed in full. Incomplete nominations will NOT be considered. Applicants must not contact members of the selection committee regarding the status of their nomination.









Successful Regional Nominees

Successful nominees will be notified in November 2023.

Provincial Awards

Regional recipients will automatically serve as nominees for the Provincial Awards. Nominees will be reviewed by the Provincial Selection Committee and 10 Provincial recipients will be notified in early 2024. Provincial recipients will receive an invitation to attend a virtual Provincial Awards ceremony, their profile will go on display at the BC Sports Hall of Fame, and they will receive a cash bursary.
